- The "Mostra della Camelia" (Camellia Exhibition) in Verbania, the emblem of flower production that began 150 years ago in the Lake Maggiore area and now plays a major role in the European sector, with 5 million specimens cultivated by around a hundred companies in our area. www.lagomaggiorefiori.it

- **Musical firework displays:** summer 2018 will see the return of the highly-anticipated and successful fireworks and musical pyrotechnics shows, which every year attract a large Italian and international audience of over 300,000 people to the area, offering thrilling displays in a natural lakeside and mountain setting. www.distrettolaghi.it

The traditional summer music festivals have also been already confirmed: **Stresa Festival**, one of the most important classical music festivals worldwide, "**Musica in Quota 2018**" (Music at High Altitude), The **Festival di Musica Barocca** "**Di Parola in Musica**" ('Words in Music' Baroque Music Festival) will return for the fourth year running, **Un Paese a Sei Corde** (A Six-String Country), the 13th **Festival Organistico Internazionale** "Sonata Organi" ('Organ Sonata' International Organ Festival), **Amenoblues** in the hills of Lake Orta (14<sup>th</sup> edition), the 22<sup>nd</sup> Ossola Guitar Festival, Tones on the Stones and its art in the historic caves, the **Miasino Jazz Festival**, the "Festival Cusiano di Musica Antica" (Cusiano Early Music Festival), "Orta Festival", the "Concerti di Mezzogiorno" (Concerts at Noon) and the "Settembre Musicale di San Giulio" (San Giulio's Musical September).

Cultural and literary events will include: the prestigious "Lakescapes – Teatro diffuso del lago" (Lakescapes – Popular Lake Theatre), the Book Fair La Fabbrica di Carta, the Festival Lago Maggiore LetterAltura (Lake Maggiore LetterAltura Festival) and the 8th edition of "Il Teatro sull'Acqua" (The Theatre on the Water)

Between spring and autumn, there will also be many events dedicated to food and wine, folklore and traditions: "La vita tra Leponti e Walser" (Life between Leponti and Walser), the 32<sup>nd</sup> Fiera di San Bernardo, "Sapori di Lago" (Lake Flavours) in Baveno, the "Sagra della Patata" (Potato Festival) in Montecrestese, the 37<sup>th</sup> Raduno Internazionale dello Spazzacamino (International Meeting of Chimney Sweeps), the 93<sup>rd</sup> "Festa dell'Uva" (Grape Festival) in Masera and the "Sagra del Cinghiale" (Wild Boar Festival) in Migiandone.



2018 also promises to be an innovative, exciting year for scheduled sports competitions, including the **Vco Top Race** circuit with its 13 races that cover around 800 km of our region from April to October and the 8th "**Lake Maggiore Marathon**", which boasts the most scenic route in Italy.



Like every year, there will be endless outdoor activities offered by the beautiful landscape and numerous recreational activities: lake cruises and train tours on board the "Trenino delle Centovalli".
